High Leigh information

- A Manager is on-call for the duration of your stay and the main office is staffed from approximately 8.00 am to 10:00 pm. Out of hours a Duty Manager can be contacted in an emergency by calling 07918 188 888.
- All bedrooms are en suite.
- There is plenty of parking at High Leigh and also two electric car charging points available (clearly marked in front of the access doors to rooms 55/56). - Key cards will be issued at registration which will be co-ordinated by Paul Goodliff and Joe Aldred in the main reception area from 2.00 pm.

If you are the last in a meeting room, please turn off all lights and use your key card to lock the door behind you – a red light confirms that it has locked.
